All fishing gear was generously donated in Memory of Aaron Purtell by the Greater Nipissing Stewardship Council and Dowdal Cabinets through their Rod and Tackle Share Program.

The library is not liable for any injuries which may incur with the Rod and Tackle Share Program and is not responsible for ensuring borrower's licensing.

Borrowers must have a valid Bonfield Public Library card and are in good standing order in order to check out a Rod and Tackle Share Kit.

Borrowers are responsible for the safe-keeping and return of these items to the library and assume liability for the equipment while it is in their care. Borrowers are responsible for damaged and/or missing pieces of the lent items.

The library is not responsible for unforeseen equipment failure.

The lending period is seven (7) days. The Rod and Tackle Share kit may be renewed one (1) time and must be returned directly to the BPL. The Rod and Tackle Share kit may not be returned in the outdoor book drop or left outside the library. There is a \$5.00 per day late fee per kit up to a maximum of \$100.00. Children 15 and under must have permission from a parent or guardian.

The Rod and Tackle Share kit is not considered returned until all items associated with it, including (but not limited to) a 6 Gallon Pail with Jig Box & cushioned seat, Pail Wire Combo Rod Holder, Two Ice Lures, Two Glow Treble Hooks, Poly Flex Ice Skimmer, Four Removable Split Shots, Depth Finder, Three Tip-up Line markers, polar tip-up with tip-up with tip-up line and slab master medium Rod Combo have been returned to the library in good cleaned condition. If any items are missing or not in the same condition upon its return, the library reserves the right to refuse acceptance of the equipment and/or condition until all items are returned. This refusal does not waive any late fees.

The library reserves the right to deny the use of Rod and Tackle Share kit to any borrower.

Borrowers agree to abide by the library policy and procedures.
