

CAPITAL REPLACEMENT PLAN

The Bonfield Public Library has an inventory of *specialized equipment* and technology systems necessary for the efficient delivery of services to the public. The identifiable inventory needs to be replaced or upgraded based on their projected life spans.

A Reserve Fund was created in 2007 for the purpose of meeting future financial obligations with respect to library *specialized equipment* and technology systems requiring major repair, upgrade or replacement. The reserve account is funded annually through surplus from the operating library budget, collected revenues or general fund appropriation.

Statement of Sustainability for Ontario Trillium Foundation Equipment Funded in 2015:

The Bonfield Public Library, in collaboration with the Blue Sky Region Community Network, graciously received a \$9,000 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation. The board and staff of the Bonfield Public Library are honoured to receive this grant and thank the Ontario Trillium Foundation for their support and the opportunity to improve and enhance our services to our municipality. The following is a detailed inventory and their value purchased in 2015 with Ontario Trillium Foundation funds:

These two items will be considered as *specialized equipment*. If any major repair or replacement is required they will be financially sustained from the Bonfield Public Library Reserved Fund. A goal of \$500 per year for 15 years will be set aside within the reserve for the above equipment replacement plan.
