## BONFIELD PUBLIC LIBRARY BRIEF HISTORY

- 1973 By-Law 9-73 of the Town of Bonfield establishing a Public Library
  - Mrs. Cécile Boisvert was offered the position of Librarian at a salary of \$3.00 per hour.
- Official opening of the Library was held Wednesday September 7, 1977 at 7:00 pm
  - The Library Board approach the Coucil of East Ferris, Calvin, Chisholm and Papineau with a view in forming a Union Public Library with neighbouring municipalities.
- The Board undertook to establish a Committee to collect books and documents of a historical nature pertaining to the community in advance of the Bonfield Centennial.
- Maurice Shank was named Chairperson of the Bonfield Library Historical Committee to undertake the project 80-15 on February 16, 1981 in preparation of the Township Centennial in 1986
- In August, 1982 the library was closed for one week to move the library from Saint Jeanne D'Arc School to the new quarters.
- 1986 Carpet was installed
- 1992 Book Return Box was purchased and Installed
  - Circulation Desk was built by Mr. John Stewart
- 1993 Library was Painted white
  - Policy and Procedure Manual was created updated in 1996, 1999, 2010,2016
- First Computer was purchased
  - First Photocopier was purchased from Nipissing Copier
- Submission was made to Industry Canada on October 16, 1997 for The Community Access Program (CAP)
  - Calvin Township dissolves their contractual agreement with the library Board, September 10, 1997
  - New By-Laws was established on December 31, 1997
  - CAP proposal submission, June 26, 1997 Accepted on October 16, 1997 Contract signed in February, 1998
- The Library Board becomes members of the OLA (Ontario Library Association) June 1998
- Arch Engineering received \$588.50 for the drawings required in the Library Renovation (Removing a Wall)
  - Mike's Construction was hired in the sum of \$4,290.70 for the removal of the center wall on July 12, 1999
  - Library was Painted Green
- Exterior yard Light was installed on the East side of the parking lot near the library entrance
  - NECO (\$2,000) Grant shelves
  - Environment grant from the Canada Trust in the amount of \$2,500 was awarded to purchase books/VHS related to the environment
  - Exterior yard light was installed on the East side of the parking lot near the library entrance
- 2001 Friends of the Library Group was established February 5, 2001
  - Spectrum Suite -SAGEBRUSH-Software was purchased November 5, 2001 (\$2,459.46)
  - Library hours increased from 19hrs per week to 24hrs
  - VDX Interlibrary Loan was introduced on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2001
  - Library was broken into Stolen items: Televesion, VCR, Laminator, Scanner and one Printer
  - Security System was installed in September, 2001
- The Board authorize Greg Boxwell on March 4, 2002 to pursue information and funding from the Ministry of Tourism, Culture & Recreation under the "Sustainability for Public Internet Access Program".
  - The Board adopted the new Bonfield Public Library Policy Manual as amended on May 6, 2002.
  - Wee One Story Hour was launch October 1, 2002 from 10:30 to 11:30 am

instructor Linda Virgoe, Program name changed in 2003 to the Sandman Story hour and was

moved to every Monday evening from 6-7pm with Patricia Vezina the Instructor

The Sandman Story Hour was moved Tuesdays 10:30-11:30am in 2015

- 2003 Purchase of the stand alone desk \$373.75 Country Heritage North Bay 741 Wallace Road
  - High Speed Internet arrived April 2003
  - Removed the showcase (trophy) and replaced with shelving
- Shelving was purchased from Brodart March 4th, 2004 \$7092 using money from the Trillium Foundation
  - The Bonfield Public Library Board agreed to adopt the Township of Bonfield's Procurement By-Law 2004-40
- 2005 Trillium Grant was accepted for improvement of accessibility was implemented summer 2006

- DNSSAB sponsored after school program
- 2006 New Flooring tiles and carpet, new shelving a new access door and ramp thanks to a successful Trillium Grant
- LSDF funding was accepted to digitize the Rutherglen Women Institute Collection.
  - May 2007 conference table purchased from Brodart \$1,416.16 with LSDF funding.
  - The Library Board supported Nip U & Canadore College in the reciprocal Borrowing Partnership program. (PALS)
  - 9,000.00 Family Literacy Grant from the ministry of culture was set in a reserve fund
- 2008 New Provincial Holiday is recognized in February, 2008 as Family Day
  - The Board accepted the quote from Carr & McLean for the purchase of Shelving from the Board Account \$3,174.44
  - The Board approves payment from the Board account to Better Business Systems in the amount of \$1,124.35 for a Toshiba Photocopier (funded by the Friends of the Library)
- 2009 The Board accepts the Bonfield Public Library Strategic Plan 2009-2012
  - The Board approved the payment in the amount of \$312.99 for the purchase of JFJ Easypro CD/DVD Disc Cleaner and Repair system (funded by the Friends of the Library)
  - Wireless internet arrived Dec. 14, 2009
- 2010 New Acer Lap-Top was purchased (Funded by CAP)
  - \$15M Project was completed by December 31, 2010

(Received .\$15,921 grant plus \$1,389.57 HST rebate total revenue =\$17,310.57)
