Policy Title: **Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit Library Lending Program Policy**

The Bonfield Public Library in partnership with Ontario Parks is pleased to take part in the **Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit Library Lending Program**. This permit allows free access for one vehicle and its occupants into participating Ontario Provincial Parks where entry fees are normally charged.

The Library does not assume responsibility for damages, personal injury, illness or theft arising from participating in the program, or in any facility, or at any location where this program is held.

Borrowers must have a valid Bonfield Public Library card and are in good standing order to check out the Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit pass;

The Ontario Parks Day-use vehicle permit passes are not available for interlibrary loan;

Borrowers may borrow only one (1) park pass per household at a time for a maximum of one (1) week (7days);

The Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit pass may be borrowed multiple times by the same library card holder, but never for two consecutive lending periods. After borrowing the pass, you will be required to wait a minimum of one week to request to borrow it again;

The Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit pass is first come, first served. You will be required to sign our borrowing agreement;

The Ontario Parks Day-use Vehicle Permit does not guarantee park entry. Park operating season and capacity limitations will apply;

A late fee of \$20/day will apply. If the Ontario Park Day-Use Vehicle Permit pass is lost, misplaced or damaged, the pass will become null and void and patrons will be charged the replacement cost of a Commercial Day-Use Vehicle Permit including applicable taxes and any additional fees incurred;

The permits must be displayed on the rear-view mirror or dashboard of the vehicle while it is in a park. Borrowers must abide by park rules;

The library will not be responsible for unforeseen costs incurred by the borrower;

Ontario Parks Day-Use Vehicle Permit pass may be returned in the outdoor book drop; and

The library reserves the right to deny the use of the Park pass to any borrower who repeatedly returns it late.

# Provincial Park Pass 2021

## Bonfield Public Library Borrowing Agreement

The Provincial Park Permit is valid from January 1<sup>st</sup> through to December 31<sup>st</sup> 2021 and is available for borrowing through the Bonfield Public Library. If you are borrowing the Provincial Park Permit, you are agreeing to the following terms:

1. That the Provincial Park Permit may be borrowed for a maximum period of one week (7 days).
2. That the Provincial Park Permit may be borrowed multiple times by the same person and/or family, but **never** for two consecutive lending periods in a row. After you have borrowed the pass, you will have to wait a minimum of one week to borrow it again to give other people an opportunity to use it. No holds will be available.
3. The library will not be responsible for unforeseen costs incurred by the borrower.
4. The permits must be displayed on the rear view mirror or dashboard of the vehicle while it is in a park.
5. A **late fee** will apply for each day you are late in returning the Provincial Park Permit. This late fee is set at **\$20 per day** (the maximum cost for a day-use vehicle permit to visit the park).
